"Much as the poker playing habits of Dave Kalakaua, afterward king of the Sandwich Islands, have been written about," said Dr. Edward Bedloe, former United States consul at Canton, China, at the Waldorf-Astoria the other night, says the New York Telegraph, "Kalakaua remains the most interesting figure in the history of the seductive sport. Kalakaua was a sportsman all through. He became a finished poker player when he was still Dave Kalakaua, walking around Honolulu without any idea that he would ever become king of the islands, and in those days he turned the tables on numerous professional card sharps from the Pacific coast, who made periodic visits to the islands from San Francisco for the purpose of gathering in all the loose money in and about Honolulu.

"Kalakaua loved to play poker with men that he liked. He was a game loser and he was one of the most unargumentative men imaginable when disputes arose as to the finer points of the game. He simply would not argue, and he invariably passed the pot over to the man of an argumentative disposition—not in an aggressive way, calculated to make the other fellow feel small for taking the money, but cheerfully and courteously—and that's one of the reasons that I always considered Kalakaua a high grade man and a proper gentleman.
