WILL REFUSE TO STEP OUT Chiefs Getchell and McIntire Say They Will Not Give Up Their Offices to Their Successors.

Immediately after he had taken the oath of office yesterday, Mayor Smith sent to the council the following list of removals and appointments in the police department:

John J. O'Connor, chief of police, vice P. H. Getchell, removed. Meyerling, lieutenant, vice Joseph Davis, removed. Daniel L. Ahern, detective, vice John Christensen, removed.

When the duplicate communications, one addressed to the assembly and the other to the board of aldermen, arrived in the council chamber, the common council was in session, with President Schiffmann in the chair.
