MARRIAGE IN DAVENPORT CASE

GOV. LIND IS CONVINCED, AND REFUSES TO GRANT EXTRADITION PAPERS SUSTAINED BY DOUGLAS

Chas. P. Packer, of Illinois, now in Minneapolis, charged in an extradition proceeding drawn by Cook county officials with embezzlement, will probably enjoy his liberty, as long, at least, as he remains in Minneapolis. The case has been pending before Gov. Lind for some time. The governor is convinced that there is malice behind the prosecution of Mr. Packer, and has refused to honor the requisition of Gov. Tanner, of Illinois. He will, however, hear additional evidence, but it is in no wise likely that this will swerve him from his asserted intention. His position is based upon the opinion given by Attorney General Douglas, which deals with the question raised by Mr. Packer's accusation, that the governor is not vested with discretionary power in the matter of honoring extradition papers, but that his duty is imperative. Before finally refusing to honor Gov. Tanner's requisition this matter was referred to the attorney general, who cites the law on the question, which rather favors the contention made by the Illinois people, but in giving a number of citations and relating the rule of custom the governor has the best of it. The supreme court decisions bearing upon the subject also support the governor in his refusal to turn Mr. Packer over to the Illinois authorities. A United States supreme court decision holds that "the executive or authority of a state upon which the demand is made should be satisfied by competent proof that the party is so charged," etc. The governor believes Mr. Packer is being persecuted.
