The staid body of representative citizens, the Chamber of Commerce, was taken by surprise by Walter Chapin yesterday, when he introduced a resolution for passage and subsequent presentation to the representatives of the state in congress.

DAVIS MEMORIAL PROPOSED. Aside from this, the most important matter taken up was a resolution for the erection of statues to Senator Davis as follows: "The committee on legislation be instructed to prepare a petition to the incoming legislature asking for an appropriation for the erection of a statue by the state to the memory of the late senator, Cushman Kellogg Davis, the same to be erected upon the new state capitol grounds, and that provision be made for the same to be placed in the capitol grounds, under the provision of congress by which each state is allowed to place two memorial statues thereon."
