### COUNTY ATTORNEY BOARDMAN INTRODUCES EVIDENCE FOR THE PROSECUTION

"No questions," replied Mr. Penney. Dr. J. Warren, the second witness, testified that he took part in the post-mortem held at the morgue Nov. 25, and proceeded to describe the wounds:

"The principal one," he said, "was on the left side just above the collarbone—a gaping wound, through the skin and underlying tissues, completely severing the subclavian artery under the clavicle. It penetrated the apex of the left lung. Day had a wound on the right side of the head a little above the ear. It penetrated the apex of the skull, cutting a cut on the upper lip on the left side, breaking the mucous membrane on the left side a little. He had, too, a cut on the left shoulder two and a half inches from the armpit and on a level with it. The left cut was superficial. There were other abrasions at other points. The back of the left wrist was bruised, and the left ankle was bruised on the inside and outside."

### POSITION TAKEN BY DEFENSE

Leading Witnesses for the State to Be Impugned on Grounds That They Were Intoxicated.

"The trial of Frank H. Hamilton, on a charge of having murdered Leonard R. Day was begun yesterday before Judge Brooks and an immense gathering of spectators, which completely overtaxed the capacity of the large court room. Prominent among those were six relatives of the murdered man, and Miss Caroline Slagle, whose testimony is expected to have a bearing on the motive for the murder.

In opening for the state County Attorney Boardman gave the first hint as to the evidence which the prosecution will most strongly rely upon in its attempt to convict Hamilton of murder outright.

"We will show you," said Mr. Boardman to the jury, "that before Hamilton was advised by his attorney to keep still and say nothing about it in the early morning of the time he confessed to an officer; said he did it in self-defense, and was prepared to take the consequences."

This statement has to do with the defendant's alleged confession to Patrolman Rooney, who first took him in custody. A slight reference was made in the press at the time to Hamilton's having "made a clean breast of it," but since then, until the county attorney opened his mouth this morning, not another word has been about it.

DEFENSE IS PREPARED.

The defense, it is understood, has fully prepared to meet the state on this vital point. It is said that Mr. Penney and Mr. Nye, defendant's counsel, are prepared to show conclusively to the satisfaction of both court and jury that no such evidence, being admitted, coming from the officer alone, will be admissible under the statutes.

Mr. Penney's questioning of Ralph L. Gary, witness for the state, was also that the defense will attempt to disqualify leading witnesses on the ground of intoxication at the time of the stabbing. Mr. Penney was evidently bent on showing that all in the room at the time were so much under the influence of liquor that they were incompetent witnesses and their testimony unreliable.
