LOCAL COMMITTEES ARE BUSY

St. Paul Physicians Sparring No Pains to Make the Meeting a Success—Attendance Will Be Large.


Plans are being actively arranged for the fifty-fourth annual meeting of the American Medical Association, says the St. Paul Medical Journal, and there every reason to believe that the meeting will be a large one. The details of the local committee work are in the hands of Dr. J. F. Fulton, chairman of the committee on arrangements; Dr. C. C. Johnson, chairman of the committee on finance; Dr. J. A. Quinn, chairman of the committee on transportation; Dr. Cornelius Williams, chairman of committee on banquets; Dr. B. Foster, chairman of the committee on entertainments; J. W. Chamberlain, chairman of committee on badges; Dr. H. L. Taylor, chairman of committee on general exhibits; Dr. Edward Boeckmann, chairman of committee on pathological exhibits; Dr. H. J. O'Brien, chairman of committee on programs and publications; Dr. John T. Rogers, chairman of committee on halls and meeting places; Dr. E. J. Abbott, chairman of committee on bureau of information; Dr. J. B. Brimhall, chairman of committee on registration; Dr. Arthur Sweeney, chairman of committee on hotel arrangements. Continuing the Journal says: "The committee on transportation has arranged for special rates from all parts of the country and many will doubtless take advantage of the opportunity not only to attend the meeting of the association, but also to visit the various points of interest in the city. A most profitable trip is promised over the great lakes from Buffalo to Duluth, if a sufficient number can be obtained to warrant the expense of putting one of the boats in commission a couple of weeks before the regular season opens. This trip is a unique one and is not surpassed in interest in the best of its kind anywhere by any similar trip in this country; indeed we know of no similar trip to compare with it. It is more than likely that other excursions will be planned to take place after the meeting, and there are numerous trips available for those who desire to prolong their vacation and to enjoy the fishing for which the lakes and streams of Minnesota are so famous.

SOCIAL FUNCTIONS PLANNED.

"Concerning the entertainment of the members of the association we can say that this will be on a scale commensurate with the well known hospitality of the people of St. Paul and Minneapolis. On Wednesday evening, June 5, there will be several large social entertainments in St. Paul and it is planned to have that portion of Summit avenue where these entertainments are to take place, handsomely illuminated, and a band of music will be provided. On Thursday evening a large ball and promenade concert will be given by the Hennepin County and Medical societies, and the University of Minnesota on the university campus. Numerous small private affairs are being planned and a large committee of the ladies of St. Paul has been organized to take care of the visiting ladies during the mornings and afternoons of the meeting, and to make their visit enjoyable. The general sessions of the convention will be held in the Metropolitan opera house which is but a stone's throw from the Ryan block, where the bureau of registration and the general exhibit hall will be located. The social meetings will be held in various halls and churches in different parts of the city, but none of them very far apart and all within easy reach of the hotel. St. Paul is fortunate in having many excellent hotels, of modern equipment and large capacity. They are situated centrally, convenient to the various parts of the city, and the accommodations are of exceptional quality. The Ryan, with its excellent rooms, spacious lobby and large dining room, will be the general rendezvous for members of the association. The Aberdeen is beautifully situated in the residence district and will be especially desirable for those who wish to secure first-class accommodations for their families during the meeting. The Merchants' and the Windsor are roomy and modern hotels, and the latter has a large number of guests, and the Clarendon and Astoria, though smaller in size, are comfortable and very desirable stopping places. MAKES CHARGES OF FRAUD

SENATIONAL ALLEGATIONS OF RECEIVER FOR MRS. HEWITT'S ESTATE

CREDITORS WERE DEFRAUDED

Estate Undervalued to the Extent of \$11,000 and Transactions Are Designated Criminal-Interests Suit Pending.

Charges of a highly sensational character were made public yesterday when John D. O'Brien, an administrator de bonis non of the estate of Allie Hewitt, filed in the district court a complaint alleging conspiracy in the handling of the estate on the part of the executors, James B. Hewitt and A. K. Barnum. Rufus C. Jefferson and E. H. Hoard were also included.

The complaint begins with the forced resignation of Messrs. Hewitt and Barnum last January, an investigation by the new administrator, J. D. O'Brien, bringing to light a series of alleged fraudulent transactions.

When Mrs. Hewitt died she was insolvent, debts and judgments to the amount of nearly \$25,000 standing against her. The executors inventoried her estate at a little in excess of \$18,000, this being done, according to the complaint, to deceive the creditors, the real inventory being over \$25,000. On much of the property, it is alleged, the taxes were allowed to become delinquent, it subsequently being bought in by Hoard, who in turn transferred it to Messrs.

GERMANIA BANK AFFAIRS.

Depositors Protest Against Hasty Distribution of Assets.

Postponement was ordered for one week yesterday by Judge Burn in the application of the receiver of the Germania bank to be permitted to pay a dividend of 25 per cent to all creditors of the insolvent concern. The postponement was made on application of a large number of the depositors, who claimed they will be shut out of the distribution.

When the bank was reorganized after its first suspension, a large number of the stockholders were compelled to take stock as part payment of their claims. They now feel that the distribution should include them. A meeting of stockholders will be held Tuesday evening in Assembly hall to discuss the matter.

BEGINS CLEANING STREETS.

City Engineer's Men Removing the Winter's Accumulation.

An extra number of men were at work yesterday removing the dirt and slush from the down-town streets. About thirty men were at work in the central district, with a dozen teams and wagons and the street scraper.

City Engineer Clausen, in speaking of the work yesterday, said that the streets could be cleaned a great deal quicker if the occupants of downtown premises would only aid him a little by keeping their sidewalks free from dirt. It is hard enough to clean the streets, and the property owners must take care of the walks.

Speaking of the plan of flooding the streets, which has been adopted in Minneapolis, Mr. Clausen said: "It is impractical. The dirt would only clog up the sewers, and the cost of cleaning them would be five times the expense of taking up the dirt from the streets."

RUN DOWN BY A WAGON.

Mrs. Morehouse Knocked Down, but Was Not Injured Seriously.

Shortly after 7 o'clock last evening, Mrs. Morehouse, a forty-year-old woman, who lives at Dayton, Minn., was run down by a wagon owned by the Eastern Steam Heating company, and driven by S. J. Spaulding, the accident occurring at Seventh and St. Peter streets. Mrs. Morehouse was thrown from the wagon and landed on the sidewalk. She was taken to the hospital, where it was found that she had sustained no serious injuries, but was very much frightened by the shock.

Spaulding, the driver, was arrested on a charge of reckless driving and released on \$25 bail. Witnesses say that he is not to blame.

ON A TOPOGRAPHICAL SURVEY

Lieut. A. Beecher, U. S. N., and his brother, James Beecher, the latter a graduate of the Redwood Falls high school, are members of a government expedition sent to the island of Guam last fall to make a full topographical and marine survey of the island and its harbor. The following extracts are taken from a letter published recently in the Lambertton Star.

"The storm here must have been terrific. About half the trees in the island were blown down, and most of the houses were comparatively little loss of life is generally of light construction and gave away easily to the wind. The government is feeling about half the people on the island. This will probably not continue long, as everything grows quickly. We, the Guam board, have built a house 45x15 feet, and with our tents are very comfortably housed, and are fairly started on our work. All hands are well and happy. We get our drinking water from the distilling plant at Agaña, also 200 pounds of ice every third day, which is greatly appreciated.

"Directly across the bay, distant about half a mile, is Cabras island. The view across the bay and out to the sea is beautiful. To the right of Cabras island heart, and extending along the coast for several miles is a barrier reef. The nearest point of this reef is perhaps three-quarters of a mile from our house. The surf is beating upon the reef constantly, throwing the white spray into the air for many feet. In the heavy weather the breakers roll in to the height of twenty to twenty-five feet.
