NEW CARS ALMOST READY.

PATRONS ON THREE LINES TO BE GIVEN BETTER SERVICE.

GRAND AVENUE COMES FIRST.

Seventh and Rice Streets to Be Supplied as Fast as Cars Can Be Turned Out.

Citizens of St. Paul living along the Grand avenue street railway line and the Seventh and Rice street lines will be gratified to learn that within a short time big cars, similar to those now operated on the Selby avenue line, will be run on them.

It is not a matter of much surprise to learn that the cars will be placed on Grand avenue, for the question of big cars on that line has been hanging fire for a year or more, but Seventh street people, and likewise those living on Rice street, will be surprised as well as pleased. Supl. Smith, of the St. Paul Railway company, was seen with regard to the matter of new cars last night, and he said:

"Yes, Grand avenue will get the cars, and what is more, so too will Rice street and Seventh street. We are now having a large number of cars built at the shops on Thirty-first street and Nicollet, in Minneapolis, and I think I can promise you that the cars will be placed on new cars will be placed on their line in about five weeks. Of course it takes time to build the required number of cars, but I think I can assure you that within three months nothing but big cars will be operated on all three lines.

"The cars will be similar to those now being operated on the Selby avenue line, only they will be about five feet shorter. They will have the latest kind of flooring, so that when they are washed there will be no danger of injuring the motors beneath. There will be side seats and cross seats. Each of the cars will have four twenty-five-horsepower motors. In this way a motor will be attached to each wheel, thus making it a driver. Big motors are being built, and the new cars will be just about as good as they can be."

FAVOR NATIONAL BUND.

GERMAN-AMERICANS DECIDE TO JOIN PENNSYLVANIA SOCIETY.

Yesterday afternoon the German-American Central Bund held a meeting in one of the halls over the Rathskeller. There was a large attendance, the hall being packed to the limit of its standing room capacity. The object of the meeting was to discuss the formation of a national union of German-Americans in Pennsylvania.

The most important matter discussed was the proposal to join the Pennsylvania German-American Central Bund. The speaker, Mr. Martin, urged the members to support the proposal, and the motion was unanimously carried.

Mr. Martin, of the editorial staff of the St. Paul Volkszeitung, delivered an address, in which he strongly urged the members to support the proposal. He pointed out the advantages of the union, and the need for a strong German-American organization in Pennsylvania.

MOVING TO GET POSTED.

STUDENTS OF NORTH DAKOTA AGRICULTURAL COLLEGE COMING TO ST. PAUL.

Model Stock Farm in Minnesota to Be Inspected by the Embryo Farmers.

In about a week the state agricultural school and the promising stock breeders of the state will be the recipients of a most flattering compliment. A telegram has just been received by the local school from Fargo to the effect that the stock breeders class will be in that state will pay a visit to St. Paul for the purpose of "getting posted."

No detailed information has been received, but it is understood that the class will arrive here Saturday and stay for several days. The local school will do everything in its power for the entertainment of the visitors, and preparations are already under way. The embryo stock breeders will devote at least two days to a thorough examination of the school of agriculture, which has now become one of the most important branches of the state university. Next in order will be a visit to James J. Hill's stock farm, which is looked upon as being one of the best in the country. When the students have seen everything there, they will inspect the stock farm of H. F. Brown, of Minneapolis. Mr. Brown has always been greatly interested in the school of agriculture, and prides himself on the quality of the stock raised in this state. Another farm that will be visited is that belonging to N. P. Clark, of Minnetonka. This farm is two or three miles outside of the city, and is one of the most complete in the state. At the last world's fair Mr. Clark took first prize for Clydesdale horses.

The professor of the local school feel highly pleased over the coming visit.

IMPORTANT LEGISLATIVE MATTERS DISPOSED OF DURING PAST WEEK.

BOARD OF CONTROL APPROVED.

Early Adjournment Resolution Struck a Snag and Went Over to This Week—Much Work on Hand.

The house succeeded last week in getting the bill for the most important matters of the session. This was the board of control bill, which passed that body on Thursday by a vote of 73 to 39. Several other matters of great interest were taken up.

Those who were inclined to doubt the fact of this bill being a political makeshift, if it were in the house Wednesday and Thursday, when the proposition was being debated, must have had their minds changed to some extent at least. Some of the strongest and most popular Republicans in the lower branch of the legislature took the floor in opposition to the bill, denouncing it as a mere party machine move and heaping upon it a vast amount of calumny which even its bitter enemies in the opposite party had not sought to place against the measure.

The series of debates on the bill during the two days were more bitter and acrimonious than any that have been heard in the house this session. The terms in which Republican leaders denounced and condemned the measure were of the most scathing sort, and it seemed for a while that the bill's chances of passing were quite remote. At one stage of the proceedings, when the matter of debate had subsided temporarily, Mr. Umland, of the minority faction, came within a very little of ditching the whole scheme. He proposed an amendment which would have made the scope wide enough to include in its operation all the state institutions, and the amendment was at first carried by a vote of 57 to 36. Before the vote could be taken, however, Mr. Umland and other Republicans, who had voted for the Umland amendment, quickly changed their votes, making the result 69 to 54, and the amendment was lost.

EARLY ADJOURNMENT DONE FOR.

Ostensibly the house will determine upon adjournment until the 22nd of Wednesday afternoon, but in reality the proposition has been settled.
