Platinum in Ancient Egypt.

Nature. At the March meeting of the Paris Academy of Sciences M. Berthelot discussed Egyptian metals and the presence of platinum among the characters among hieroglyphic inscriptions, and dating from about 700 B. C. has a portion of one of its characters made of an alloy of platinum. The specimen was too small for a complete analysis, but from its behavior toward aqua regia is supposed to be the native platinum possibly obtained from the alluvial deposits of Nubia or the upper regions of the Nile valley.
