

U. S. RAILROAD LEADER

MORE THAN ONE-THIRD OF THE WORLD'S TRACKAGE IS IN AMERICA

TOTAL NEARLY 200,000 MILES

Germany is Second, While Russia, France, India, Austria-Hungary and Great Britain Follow in Order Named.

The announcement by the "Railway Age" that a larger addition has been made to the railway mileage of the United States in 1901 than in any preceding year since 1850...

Of these half a million miles of railway in the world, it is estimated that about one-third, or 66,000 miles, are owned by the governments of the countries in which they are located.

Comparing the mileage of other countries with that of the United States, the United States stands first with 196,778 miles; Germany second with 136,732 miles; France, 104,111; India, 75,835; Austria-Hungary, 72,919; Great Britain and Ireland, 57,200; Canada, 17,671; Brazil, 15,296; Argentina, 10,419; Italy, 8,510; Mexico, 5,695; Russia, 4,715; and Spain, 3,300 miles.
