Mr. Hoar said he really believed what he had stated, and was willing to express his views again. The senator from Georgia knew, however, that he was incapable of reflecting on his (Bacons) honor or integrity of purpose.

"What I said," replied Mr. Mason, "was that the amendment offered by the senator from Georgia was a basis of special pleading for men who should be caught in the act of taking the life of the president. It opened the doors for special pleading. What I said did not reflect directly or remotely on the honor of the senator. I was characterizing the amendment, not the senator."

Mr. Mason declared that such a measure as that pending ought to have been passed the day after the assassination of President McKinley, and that no such amendment as that presented ought to be adopted.

Without concluding the debate, the senate went into executive session.

Lady Rodney is a daughter of Baron Wilmore. She was married to Lord Rodney in 1876. Her third husband, the late Lord Rodney, died in 1899.


