NEW YORK, April 1.—The stagnant condition of the London market this morning upon the resumption of trading after the four days' interval that further deterred the hopes of the speculative contingent which has been counting upon an awakening interest in the money market.

Decreased earnings reported by the American Car and Foundry company depressed the market for steel.

The London money market was also easy today, and sterling exchange at Paris received a moderate increase.
