RUSSIAN UNREST AND PROMISE.

The peasants of Southern Russia who were recently incited to an outbreak through the medium of a canard sprung by political agitators may pay dearly for their destructive work, but they did at least, and for the first time in their lives, feel the bewildering exhilaration of him who was "a king for a day."

In this incident, as in the student riots which have for many weeks kept Russia in a condition of intermittent turmoil, we behold a sign of the times that no thoughtful observer of the trend of events in the Old World monarchies can easily misread.

The scepter of absolutism has become a monstrous anachronism that cannot and will not be tolerated much longer. The influence of the thousands of aspiring young men in the universities, of the educators and members of various professions—all in secret or open rebellion against the domination of kinglycraft—will in due time, operating patiently but constantly, complete the leaving of the lump of public opinion and compel the adoption of constitutional government in Russia.

Education and progress can make little if any popular headway in a country ruled by the unrestrained hand and irresponsible whims of czar, emperor or king. Division of authority between crown and subject, such as exists in constitutional monarchies, is necessary to the full political, moral and spiritual development of a people.
