

Minneapolis News. SPRING BIG SURPRISE Chief of Police Ames Is Indicted by the Grand Jury

TO BE ARRAIGNED TODAY Three Others Are Implicated, and Indictments Have Been Turned In—Work of Jury Not Completed.

The labors of the grand jury from 8 o'clock Thursday night until 11, and again all day yesterday were productive of results that no doubt will come as a surprise to many.

Yesterday afternoon twelve indictments were turned in, and among them were indictments against Ered W. Ames, superintendent of police; Christopher Nordbeck, plain clothes man; Irving Gardner, son of license inspector Gardner; and another indictment against James C. Howard, a plain clothes man, who was indicted several days ago.

There was some surprise when it was announced that the grand jury had been indicted, as both the men had been before the grand jury and testified, and it was the general presumption that they would be exempt from indictment.

WEATHER AND WAGES. These Continue the Only Disturbing Factors in Business Situation

BIG RAILWAY EARNINGS. Full Review of the Week's Operations in the Various Lines of Trade and Industry—The Grain Prices.

NEW YORK, May 16.—R. G. Dun & Co.'s weekly review of trade tomorrow will say: Weather and wages continue the only seriously disturbing factors in the business situation.

With about twenty more furnaces in course of construction or contemplated an annual output of 20,000 tons is no longer considered remote.

Footwear manufacturers at the East report an increased volume of orders from Western jobbers, but wholesalers in the principal Eastern centers are placing few fall contracts.

While it is generally agreed that there has been much improvement in the winter wheat states since the opening of the month, prices became somewhat firmer upon the publication of the official report of condition on May 1.


