THIRD DISTRICT POW-WOW FAILS TO CLEAR CONGRESSIONAL ATMOSPHERE

HEATWOLE HOLDS FULL HAND AND ENJOYS GAME

Northfield Congressman Declines to Announce That He Will Run Again and Leaves Republican Aspirants and Administration in Tearful and Hopeless Muddle Pending His Decision.

A conference of Heatwole men with the leader whom they have followed to victory for a decade, yesterday at the Merchants' resulted in suspending the Republican aspirants for Third district congressional honors fathoms high in still, pure air.

It also left the Heatwole men in the atmosphere of doubt which has surrounded them for several weeks. The conference was called for the purpose of forcing Heatwole to again make the race. The faithful workers went away last night not despondent, but by no means certain of ultimate success.

The conference, entirely informal, as are all conferences between Heatwole and his lieutenants, was held at the Merchants' and after two hours of argument from the side of the lieutenants and lunch, the whole party went to the ball game, while Morrison, Reed, Whitford, Wilson et al. waiting for a decisive announcement from the Third district leader, went several pegs higher in their air.

GRIST OF THE POLITICAL MILL.

The governor of Minnesota knows what he is talking about, but when the governor of Minnesota sets about making a speech he should also hire an interpreter or familiarize himself with the state he is called upon to perform. In his speech of acceptance, which the campaign committee is distributing throughout the state, the governor waded into deep water as follows: "And we are able to build a \$3,000,000 capitol without incurring \$1 of bonded indebtedness. On the other hand, we

have more than \$8,000,000 of the bonds of other states in our strong box and all that we have to do to secure the interest is to cut off the coupons. But more valuable than the bonds, even, is the sum of \$7,000,000 due on state lands, from counties, cities and townships. I say more valuable because the security is better than any state bond, and the rate of interest higher. The amount loaned since Jan. 1, 1901, is in excess of \$1,250,000. Would you preserve this credit? If so, keep the Republican party in power."

As a member of the state board of education the governor should know what he is talking about when he says there are \$7,000,000 due from counties, cities and townships for state lands. The purchase of state lands is a new branch of municipal business. It is all right because the governor says so, but it is not true, and the governor should consult some subordinate member of the state clerical force and find out what money he has helped invest.
