AFTER "DUMPED" GOODS. INTERNAL REVENUE OFFICERS RAID WHISKY HOUSES. "Dumping" of Goods Has Become Extensive and Government Will Break Up the Practice—Large Quantities of Liquors Seized and Criminal Prosecutions Will Soon Follow.

CINCINNATI, Ohio, Nov. 29.—The investigation being made by the revenue officers in Cincinnati of the alleged practice of a large number of wholesale whisky houses in putting on the market what is known to the trade and government as "dumped" goods, promises to bring forth many revelations as to the extensive business which has been carried on in this class of goods.

German Horses Fail to Score.
