#### CONSTANTLY RECEIVES DISTRESSING NEWS

Idrys Jones, a Clergyman, is Committed to the Rochester Asylum.

Idrys Jones, a Congregational minister, was committed to the insane asylum at Rochester yesterday, after an examination before a jury of physicians in the probate court, yesterday afternoon.

Rev. Jones walked into the office of Probate Judge Bazille a week ago and asked to be sent to the asylum, announcing at the time that he was demoralized. Judge Bazille, thinking perhaps the man was only temporarily insane, advised him to seek treatment at a hospital, which he did, but since going there he has become violent, and yesterday he was brought into the probate court for examination.

The patient imagines that he hears voices announcing sad events and that people are constantly trying to have him commit suicide. He is also troubled with insomnia.

#### ALDERMEN WANT LAW ON PEST HOUSE MATTER

Refer Grand Jury's Recommendations to City Attorney.

Health Commissioner Ohage last night referred to the board of aldermen the report of the grand jury condemning the present pest house on Dale street and advising the board to have a new building, but no action was taken beyond referring it to the corporation attorney.

The usual motion to file the communication was offered, but Ald. Bantz demurred and the corporation attorney was given charge of the matter, and will inform the board what it could do to relieve the situation.

#### STREET SIGNS ARE CONSPICUOUSLY ABSENT

Attention of Aldermen is Called to Failure of Lighting Company to Supply.

The board of public works last night referred to the board of aldermen that the Cleveland street lighting company, which attends to the street lights had failed to install about 400 of the street signs which its contract calls for.

At the request of Ald. Huber, City Engineer Hundert was instructed to prepare maps of all streets and corners in the city used for the conveyance of light and heat, and to have the same used for the franchise commission.

A preliminary order was introduced last night calling for the maintenance of West Seventh street from Tuscarora to Fort Snelling.

#### RONDO STREET LINE SEEMS TO BE GOOD THING

Eighty Ward People Want More of It From Avon to Chatsworth.

At the request of about 550 residents in the Eighth ward, Ald. Bantz introduced in the board of aldermen last night an ordinance providing for the extension of the Rondo street car line from Avon to Chatsworth street.

There was some discussion as to whether the street was sewered or not, and in the committee the measure was sent back to the board of aldermen for a vote. The extension will cover about three blocks and to Summit avenue for carfare purposes.

#### ST. PAUL CARNIVAL IS GRANTED STREETS

Show Will Be Held on Cedar, Eleventh and Minnesota Streets.

At the request of the St. Paul Carnival association, the board of aldermen last night granted the use of Cedar, from Eighth to Eleventh street, Eleventh, from Cedar to Minnesota, and Minnesota, from Eleventh to Summit avenue for carnival purposes.

These streets will be used by the association for the big carnival to be held the two weeks beginning July 24, and one of the conditions of the grant is that the streets be occupied no longer than Aug. 8, the close of the show. The sidewalks are not to be blocked and all property is to be protected.

### BELL BOY IS CAUGHT BEHIND LOCKED DOORS

Charged With Robberies Which Have Been Going On at the Ryan, J. Carter Makes a Desperate Dash for Liberty but Is Quickly Landed in Central Station.

J. Carter, bellboy at the Ryan hotel, was arrested last night on suspicion of having committed a robbery at the hotel. He was apprehended under peculiarly incriminating circumstances, but none of the plunder was found upon him.

Carter came to the hotel from Minneapolis nine days ago, and last Friday a gold watch was missing from parlor A. On report of the theft suspicion fell upon Carter, and since then he has been watched closely.

Last night Carter answered a bell upon one of the upper floors. The room was occupied by a man and wife. The woman was in the room, and her husband being out, and she wishing to pass the evening in the parlors of the hotel, she gave her key to Carter, instructing him to turn it in at the desk so that her husband, whom she expected to return soon, might get it and go to the room. She also gave Carter a letter and 2 cents, asking him to mail the letter.

Carter mailed the letter, and then, it is alleged, he went back up stairs to the room, which he entered, locking the door behind him.

Caught With the Door Locked. Soon after, however, the gentleman occupying the room called at the desk for the key, but as it was not there he was told that it had not been turned in. He then went to the room, which he found to be locked. Thinking his wife within, he knocked, but received no response.

He turned about and waited in the hall for several minutes, thinking that she would soon return. Soon he was surprised to hear the key turn in the lock and see Carter emerge from the door.

Wondering at the strange occurrence, he asked Carter what it meant, but received no reply. He led Carter down stairs to the desk, where he reported to Clerk Harris. Carter was then held and the central police station was notified.

### STEP-RATE PLAN IS BEING FOUGHT

No Prospect of Decisive Action At This Session of Supreme Lodge.

The supreme lodge of the A. O. U. W. devoted its attention yesterday to hearing and discussing the report of the beneficiary commission. No action was taken at the regular session, and after adjournment the delegates discussed the matters informally at the Ryan hotel.

The report of the commission presents an exhaustive summary of the assessment plan proposed by severals of the state lodges. ### BODY BURIED WITHOUT BEING IDENTIFIED

No Clue Found to Identity of Man Drowned in the River.

The body of the man found in the Mississippi river at the St. Paul boom Sunday afternoon was buried from the county morgue yesterday unidentified.

An autopsy over the body held at the morgue yesterday revealed that death was due to drowning. One leg was fractured.

### NOT FIRST TIME THE VET WAS UNDER FIRE

Policeman Saves Old Soldier From a Serious Scorching.

Sergeant Wright, of the central police station, performed a novel feat yesterday afternoon, when he extinguished a fire that was blazing away in a man's coat, the wearer being unconscious of the existence of the blaze.

David Cote, an old soldier residing at Little Canada, who was walking up Third street, was placed on trial before Judge Lewis and a jury in the criminal division of the district court yesterday, charged with criminally assaulting Lottie Lemcke, a fourteen-year-old girl. Slipka is an old offender.

Once before, when arrested upon a similar charge, he escaped from a police while being taken to the central station in the patrol wagon, but was finally captured after he had been severely wounded.

There was considerable trouble in securing a jury, but twelve men were finally selected to hear the evidence, and the case went to trial yesterday afternoon, the complainant being the first witness to testify.

### GOT TROUBLE WHERE HE LOOKED FOR IT

S. J. Griswold is Held for Creating Disturbance in Boarding House.

S. J. Griswold was arrested last night charged with creating a disturbance at a boarding house. Griswold had occupied a room at the place, and last night had a disagreement with the landlady which resulted in his paying him back the advance rent which he had paid and his taking away his trunk and effects.

After having removed all his things, Griswold returned to the place and had a dispute with two of the roomers, which led to his drawing a revolver which was taken from him by the police. He was then led out of the house and turned over to Patrolman Casserly.

Griswold told the police that he drew the revolver in self-defense, and alleged that he feared that his adversaries were trying to rob him. He deposited \$50 bail.

### Class Day at Cleveland High.

Instead of the customary public class day entertainment, the graduating class of Cleveland high school yesterday held a gathering, the invitations to which were confined to the members of the school and the faculty. The exercises consisted of the usual class day observances, followed by luncheon.

### ARCHBISHOP GIVES DIPLOMAS AT ST. THOMAS

Class of Twenty-Two Is Graduated From the Institution With High Honors -- More Buildings Will Be Needed to Accommodate Growing Needs.

In the presence of an audience of friends and relatives that fairly taxed the capacity of assembly hall at St. Paul's seminary yesterday afternoon, Archbishop Ireland conferred diplomas on twenty-two young men, graduates of St. Thomas' college.

The occasion was the eighteenth annual commencement of St. Thomas' college and was representative in that the class was one of the largest in years. The graduating class represented seven states, and perhaps was the most representative that the college has sent forth since it was instituted.

Because of the length of the programme the address of Archbishop Ireland, preliminary to conferring the diplomas, was necessarily brief, but his remarks were replete with words of congratulation and advice to the young men. He dwelt particularly on the goal they would derive from their college training and bade them not to forget their alma mater.

The salutatory was delivered by Patrick J. Lydon, of Duluth, and the class poem by William H. Grace. The valedictory, "The Literary Influence of Virgil," was delivered by Thomas A. Welch, of Marshall, Minn.
