

WARE TEARS ALL ABOUT PENSIONS

List Decreases After Total Payment of Over Three Billions.

WASHINGTON, D. C., Sept. 10.—The annual report of Commissioner of Pensions Ware places the total number of pensioners now on the rolls at 339,545, of whom 729,256 are soldiers and 267,190 are widows and dependents.

Commissioner Ware makes the following recommendations: Laws for reducing the pension of any man convicted in any court of infamy; prohibiting the giving to women who marry old soldiers after the soldiers' deaths; a different method of examining applicants for pensions, stamping the present system as uncertain, expensive, unsatisfactory and giving an enormous amount of friction.
