

Union of Carpenters. INDIANAPOLIS, Ind., Oct. 24.—The report of Adolph Strasser, of Buffalo, the empire to whom was left the question of the amalgamation of the two national organizations of carpenters, was received by President Huber at the national headquarters of the United Brotherhood today. By the report, the United Brotherhood of Carpenters and Joiners of America and the Amalgamated Society of Carpenters and Joiners are to be merged into one national organization on Jan. 1, 1905.

No Right to Seize Schooner. TORONTO, Ont., Oct. 24.—The Dominion government has lost and the Americans have won in the case of the seizure by the cruiser Petrel of the fishing schooner Kitty D. last July, for as the government claimed, illegally fishing in Canadian waters in Lake Erie. Judge Hodgins, of the admiralty court, today decided against the government's contention that the vessel was on the inside of the boundary line and ordered the restitution of the vessel to its owners at Dunkirk, N. Y. It is not unlikely a suit for damages against the Dominion government will follow.

Talk of Our Getting Greenland. HALIFAX, N. S., Oct. 24.—Replying to a reference made in the Canadian senate by Senator Forlor, of Shediac, N. B., as to the possibility of United States obtaining possession of Greenland, to the detriment of Canadian interest, the Halifax Chronicle, the leading newspaper supporter of Sir Wilfrid Laurier in Nova Scotia, advocates the purchase of the island by Canada.
