USE CHLOROFORM TO CAPTURE MANIAC

Officers' Thrilling Experience In Taking Man Who Shot His Wife to Death PEORIA, Ill., July 22.—Frank Pierce today shot and killed his wife at their home in Canton, Fulton county, and held the entire Canton police force at bay. The sheriff's force was summoned from Lewistown. Pierce after shooting his wife three times barricaded himself in the upper portion of his house and through the closed shutters announced he would kill the first officer to set foot on his premises. His mother passed in and out of the house at will, but Pierce would not permit her near the death chamber. He requested his brother-in-law, Charles McCavlin, to come to the house to talk regarding the disposition of his effects, and Fred Messier, an undertaker, to care for his wife's remains. Both refused to comply with the request. Pierce is supposed to have gone suddenly insane.

JAY GOULD GUIDES RUNAWAY HORSES

ARKVILLE, N. Y., July 22.—Jay Gould, son of George J. Gould, who is spending the summer at their mountain home near here, drove to Arkville for the mail this morning, and was standing in front of the postoffice when one of his horses caught the bridle under the neck yoke and tore it off its head. The animal jumped and soon both the horses were galloping away at full speed. Mr. Gould tried to hold them, and was having some effect on the bridled one when he neared the railroad crossing and said that unless he let them go they would dash into a moving passenger train. He let them have their heads and the horses shot across the track ahead of the train. Then ensued a wild ride along the narrow country road for three miles. Young Gould sat in the swaying wagon and guided the horses safely along a most difficult road. He crossed two narrow, covered bridges, passing a wagon in one and turned a corner with a fifty-foot embankment on the lower side. The team was stopped at Margaretville with the assistance of G. Feder, a Kentuckian, who jumped from his horse and caught the runaways. Mr. Gould was trembling from the exertion and excitement, but retained his nerve, and, fixing the bridle, drove back over the road that a few minutes before held death for him at every turn. He received an ovation from people along the way, who admired his pluck and skillful driving.
