THE GLOBE'S PAYING WANTS

OF THE FOLLOWING PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF ST. PAUL, RAMSEY COUNTY, MINNESOTA, TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF SAID CITY, FOR ADOPTION AT THE GENERAL ELECTION, TO BE HELD IN SAID CITY, ON THE EIGHTH DAY OF NOVEMBER, A. D. 1904:

AMENDMENT NO. 8. That section 29 of title I of Chapter XIII of said charter be amended by striking out the following language there-in: "There shall thereupon be paid to the owner of such property or to his agent the amount of damages which may have been awarded therefor over and above any amount of the assessment which has been collected for that purpose" and inserting the following: "The amount of damages awarded and above all other amounts which may have been awarded therefor within nine months after the date of the filing of such assessment, with interest at the rate of seven per cent per annum."

AMENDMENT NO. 9. That Chapter XIII of said charter be amended by adding thereto the following: "Section 30. The Board of Park Commissioners is hereby authorized in its order to provide for the whole or any part of the cost of the assessment which is levied for park or parkway purposes, in the case of any assessment levied for such purpose, to be paid to the owner of such property the amount of the assessment which has been collected for that purpose" and inserting the following: "The amount of damages awarded and above all other amounts which may have been awarded therefor within nine months after the date of the filing of such assessment, with interest at the rate of seven per cent per annum."

AMENDMENT NO. 10. That Chapter XIII of said charter be amended by adding thereto the following: "Section 31.
