
VEAGER'S BIG HORSE HITS TRACK RECORD

LOS ANGELES, Cal., Dec. 23.—Waswift, Yeager's big chestnut horse, showed some of his speed exhibited at Ascot last year when he hung up the track record of 1:33 1/2 for the mile, with 124 pounds up, by winning the third race today from Filipe Luego and Kenilworth. Waswift was almost overlooked in the betting. He drifted from 5 to 1 to 8 to 1 in the books, while Kenilworth was played from 2 to 1 to 8 to 5. Waswift took command at the head of the stretch and won easily. Three favorites took first money. Weather cloudy; track fast.
