Englishmen Find Great Diversion in Orgies of Pentecostal Contortionists

LONDON, Jan. 7.—A very strange sect has just arrived in London from Western America. They are known as the Pentecostal Dancers of the Order of the Burning Bush, and have their headquarters at Denver, Colo. They appear to wear no special dress, the men and women both being clad in ordinary modern clothes, the extraordinary part of the American revivalists' programme lying in the dancing which accompanies the singing of many hymns. They have appeared at the Camberwell Baths hall, and have up to the present drawn audiences of a very mixed character, who have come to watch the Pentecostal dancers for very different reasons.

Dancers Tread Strange Measure  
A correspondent who visited one of these Pentecostal meetings thus describes what he saw:  
"Apparently the greater part of Camberwell was already there and whistling its appreciation of the proceedings. Upon the platform the Pentecostal dancers were treading a strange measure. Five women, attired somewhat after the manner of hospital nurses, bobbed and jigged backward and forward. Two men linked hands and skipped away again. A sixth lady at the piano furnished the accompaniment to their desultory chanting. Then one of the five came forward and expressed her ecstasy at being privileged to address the meeting. 'I just feel like as if a tub of honey had been upset in my soul,' she declared.

"A cynic might perhaps trace an analogy between the picturesque American phrase and the Scottish 'hea in the bonnet.' Then came more dancing, followed by an address from a gentleman with 'mutton chop' whiskers and an unintelligible delivery, much appreciated by the irreverent youth of Camberwell. A lady followed with a negro melody which became, if anything, too popular; the crowded house caught the air with lightning rapidity and relieved the soloist from any further responsibility in the matter.  
"After a quartet on the same lines another speaker addressed the meeting. His condemnation of Apostle John Alexander struck one as being humorous. In the course of his address the crowd meanwhile included 'Bill Bailey,' 'Home, Sweet Home,' and other popular ditties."

Interesting Psychological Study  
Among those who have visited the meetings of the Pentecostal dancers have been many of the students of psychology, to whom this religious phenomenon is of more than usual interest. Spasmodic revivals of the ancient dancing crazes are not new. The order of Shakers may be specially mentioned as a type of sect in which certain convulsive movements are imagined by the members to have some moral or spiritual significance. The Dancing Derivatives are another well known case in which the dancing mania is connected with religious ceremonies.

In the middle ages the dancing mania appeared at Aix in connection with the wild festival of St. John. The dancing craze spread to an extent which has probably never been equaled. Crowds of these dancers, who set out on tour, passed through many of the German towns, through which they danced to the notes of an exciting type of music that almost invariably accompanied the dancing craze. Numbers of the citizens of the various towns caught the mental infection and followed the leading dancers throughout the streets, surging into the streets. The miserable conditions which then existed doubtless assisted the spread of the craze, which was followed by a period of great disorder and profligacy. The jumping movements of the medicine chronicled concerning this historic outbreak seem to suggest the movement of the Pentecostal dancers. In the beginning of the tenth century Paracelsus, the greatest reformer of medicine, found that immersion in cold water was an almost certain cure for the cases of dancing mania which existed in his day.

GIRL FOOLS BANDITS

Saves \$1,500 From Clutch of Armed Robbers

CHICAGO, Jan. 7.—The presence of mind of Mary Kelfeather, a cashier employed in the warehouse of Franklin MacVeagh, 242 Newberry avenue, saved the company from being robbed \$1,500 yesterday. This amount of money was delivered to the warehouse and given to Miss Kelfeather. After counting the money, which was in packages, she turned to place it in the safe, when she was confronted by two masked men who entered carrying revolvers.

"Not so quick, young woman," one of the men said.  
Miss Kelfeather refused to turn the money over to the men, and shut the safe door.  
With her hand on the combination she attempted to lock the safe. She was so terrified that when one of the men placed a revolver to her forehead her hand seemed paralyzed, and she let it fall to her side.  
"If you treat us right we will not harm you," one of the men said.  
Miss Kelfeather regained her composure, and when the men were about to open the safe door she screamed and hid her face in her hands, fearing she would be killed, as the men had threatened her.  
The men jumped back, and when four employees entered the office from a rear room they drove them back at the points of their revolvers.  
The men then left the office, warning the employees that if any followed they would be shot. Meanwhile Miss Kelfeather turned the combination on the safe door.
