How true that is. While the building of a great enterprise is indeed a wonderful accomplishment, how much grander is the building of a good character.

## Clem Studebaker.

The man who builds a good wagon may do as much to push along the forces of civilization as the man who builds a great poem, who delivers a soul-stirring oration or places a new law on the statute books of his country. Indeed, the wagon-builder may do more than all these for civilization, especially if he scatters the wagons by the thousands in every land where man has learned to till the soil, as did Clem Studebaker of South Bend.

We are prone to extol the architect of ideas, the word-builder, the coiner of great phrases, rather than the silent artificer and organizer in the realm of industrial endeavor. But if we judge him by the measure of his achievement in a department of activity that contributed to the advancement of a race, that helped man to conquer the forces of nature and to place them under tribute to man's comfort and happiness, we will have to say that Clem Studebaker was one of the giants of his time.

Coming from fine old German stock and trained in the severe school of piety and frugality, he was well fitted to become a great captain of industry. From a little blacksmith and wagon-shop he and his brothers built up the largest vehicle manufacturing plant in the world. For four decades and more the great plant at South Bend has sent out a never-ending procession of wagons to every quarter of the globe where man has grasped the rudiments of civilization.

But Clem Studebaker is greater than the wagon industry at South Bend, greater than the splendid edifices the Studebakers have reared in Chicago and other cities. He was great in the simplicity and beauty of his character, great in his generous kindness to the poor, great in his loving fidelity to the religion he learned at his mother's knee, great in his devotion to those ideals which exalt the home and beautify the common life.

Like most men who have organized and directed colossal industries, Mr. Studebaker was unostentatious.
