Progress in Civil Service Reform.

The recent annual meeting of the National Civil Service Reform League was perhaps the first at which no criticism was passed upon the President.

The President has appointed one of the leaders of the movement to the Civil Service Commission; has given notice of his intention to disregard politics in army, navy, and colonial appointments; has included some of the rural free delivery employes in the classified service; has modified the rules of the Indian Bureau and has urged consular reform upon Congress.

Another executive act in furtherance of civil service reform which has attracted less attention than those just mentioned is really one of the most important. This is the amendment of the civil service rules, with a view to making it harder for spoilsmen to get into the service and easier to get them out when they have somehow slipped in.

The progress of reform is curiously illustrated in the recent case of Mr. Marley. That a man holding the position of laborer in a navy-yard should think seriously of contesting the right of the President himself to remove him without a hearing shows how ideas have changed since the comparatively recent times when officials of all grades were liable to discharge by their superiors at mere caprice or for political reasons.


