It now looks as though Jasper will celebrate on the Fourth of July. If she does it will be the first celebration she has had for five years, so watch out for a warm time.

The Missouri Experiment Station advises the farmers to plant corn up to as late as the first of July. If you haven't done so before, finish your corn planting on the first of July and come to Jasper and celebrate on the Fourth.

By a vote of three to one Carthage decided to tear down a \$30,000 brick school building and erect a stone structure costing \$75,000 in its stead. If Carthage can do that Jasper ought to be willing to sacrifice a \$3,000 frame structure for a \$7,500 building.

In the minds of the members of the school board an extra room will be needed next term. There is no reason why the board should desire an extra room unless it is actually needed. So give the schools a chance to expand by voting the board the necessary privilege next Tuesday of providing an extra room.

Jasper can be thankful that she has not a couple of other towns within a radius of three miles, as is the case in the Neck City-Alba-Purcell district. These three towns are within a radius of three miles and it promises to be nip and tuck as to which will be the representative town of the district. Neck City has won out on the depot proposition which would seem to give it the advantage. In order to beat the new town of Purcell out of the depot Alba and Neck City agreed to arbitrate the matter as to which of the two should be given the depot. The question was decided in favor of Neck City.

Perry Heath, Politics and Law-breaking.

A public office, such as the Postoffice Department, may be administered on either of two principles. In common speech one is known as the "business" principle, the other as the "political."

It was for the purpose of administering the postoffice on the political principle that Perry S. Heath was in 1897 made first assistant postmaster general. Everybody knew it. He was to be a distributor of patronage and the official "headman."

We now learn that the essence of his work was neither more nor less than law-breaking. Recent revelations have shown during the three years of his incumbency of office "Perry Heath," political management and "lawbreaking" were almost synonymous terms.

The latest proof of this is given by the records of the Civil Service Commission, which shows that in a single year Mr. Heath violated the civil service law sixty times in making appointments to clerkships in the general department alone. This does not include illegal appointments in the Washington postoffice, which had previously come to light. Of these sixty clerks wrongfully appointed thirteen were at once advanced to the important posts of inspectors.

Nor was this all. In addition to breaking the law directly Mr. Heath, it has become clear, served as a general adviser and friend in all the offices in which "political administration" and fraud went hand in hand. In Tyner's and M. Chen's and Beaver's offices his traces have been found.

It is a bitter chapter in the history of "that very easily bled institution," as the London Times calls our Postoffice Department, that the people of the United States are reading today. Bitter reflection, no doubt, is leading to good resolutions.

But it should be remembered that there is only one way by which the recurrence of the offense and rereading of the unpleasant chapter can be prevented. Public opinion must rouse itself to an effective demand that the business principle be thoroughly and completely substituted for the political in the government service. It is beyond controversy that as long as the latter is countenanced it will find more Heaths and produce more lawbreaking, and that the old bad trinity will lead through more scandals to fresh shams.
