M. & N. A. ROAD TO USE ELECTRIC CARS

Seligman, April 4.—The first electric motor passenger cars to be installed on a steam railroad in Missouri will be placed in service on the Missouri and North Arkansas railroad, between Seligman, Mo., and Eureka Springs, Ark., about June 1st. Two cars, costing about \$25,000 each and each carrying eighty-six passengers, were ordered previous to the receivership and will be delivered next month.

Similar electric motor cars have been installed recently on some of the eastern railroads and the Frisco has bought several for its Texas service, but the cars have not yet been tried out in the rough Ozark regions of Missouri. The cars have a maximum speed of sixty-five miles an hour on a level track.

The cars are propelled by electricity, generated by gasoline engines on the front end of the car. The cars are entered at the center and passengers must leave by the rear. Each car has two passenger compartments, a smoking-car, and a baggage-compartment and an observation platform at the rear.

NEGRO LAD SENDS FRISCO LOCOMOTIVE ON WILD RUN

Fort Scott, Kan., April 4.—The inquisitiveness of a fifteen year old colored boy might have resulted disastrously for the Frisco, as it resulted in engine 1280, one of the monster engines in service on that road, running wild on the north end. The engine was captured near Hammond some time later by an engine and crew sent in pursuit but not until orders had been issued for the southbound local train to take siding at Hammond and clear the main line until orders had been issued for all trains along the division to clear for the runaway. No damage resulted.

The engine had been left standing on the main in readiness for a run. It had been fired up and gauges registered 200 pounds of steam, enough to have carried it many miles. The colored boy, who has been in the habit of loitering in the Frisco yards mounted to the cab and seated himself in the engineer's seat. Reaching for the throttle he opened it "just a little," as he had seen others do in handling engines and it started. Not knowing what to do to bring the engine to a stop he jumped from the cab.

Instead of running away as many others would have done under like circumstances, the boy ran immediately to the yard men working near and told them what had occurred. A freight train had just pulled in from the south and orders were given the crew at once to cut off their engine and start in pursuit.
