RESOLUTION NO. 129

Declaring it necessary to improve the roadway portion of Bond street from the east curb line of Fourth street, thence east to the West curb line of Fifth street by constructing first class Combined Concrete Curb and Gutter on both sides thereof.

Be it Resolved by the Council of the City of Monett, Missouri as follows: Section 1. That the Council deems and declares it to be necessary to improve both sides of the roadway portion of Bond street in the City of Monett from the east curb line of Fourth street, thence east to the west curb line of Fifth street by excavating, filling, preparing foundations therefore, and constructing thereon first class combined Concrete Curb and Gutter on both sides of said Bond street between the lines aforesaid, and including the returns on the extensions into intersecting streets and alleys, within the above named distance.

Section 2. That said improvement shall be done in accordance with the plans, Estimates of cost and the specifications of the City Engineer, filed in the office of the City Clerk, and subject to the inspection of the public, and general Ordinance No. 463 of said City approved on the 23rd day of April, 1912, entitled "An Ordinance providing for concrete combined curb and gutter and defining the manner in which the improvement shall be done."

Section 3. The portion of said Bond street herein named and hereby declared necessary to be improved, being less than twelve hundred feet in length, any one desiring to do so may appear before the Council at the Council room in the City Hall, in said City of Monett, on the 15th day of March, 1921 at the hour of 2 o'clock p. m., and be heard on the question of the necessity of the work and improvement herein deemed and declared by the Council necessary to be done. As provided by Section 8325 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri, for the year 1919.

Section 4. To pay for said improvement a special assessment shall be levied and special tax bills shall be issued in accordance with Sections 8323 and 8324, of the Revised Statutes of the State of Missouri, for the year 1919, against all lots and tracts of land abutting on both sides of said Bond street along the distance improved and improvement, in proportion to the front foot thereof, charging to the corner lots the cost of extensions into intersecting streets and alleys, and the cost thereof shall be included in the special assessment for paying for said Combined Concrete curb and gutter and the tax bills to be issued therefore, also the cost of excavating and filling shall be included in the special assessment and the tax bills to be issued therefore, the general revenue fund of the City, in the opinion of the Council, not being in a condition to warrant an expenditure therefrom for any of such purposes.

Section 5. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval. Passed and approved this 1st day of March, 1921.
