MOVING PALACE BY BITS.

Novel Method of Transporting Michigan Mansion to Boston.

Piece by piece the \$500,000 mansion of John M. Longyear has begun to come to Brookline, a suburb of Boston, from Marquette, Mich., says the New York World. It will take several months for the entire structure, mostly of stone, to be transported east, and then it will be built again on a magnificent site which Mr. Longyear bought last December in the fashionable Boston suburb. The other day sixteen car loads of the house arrived at Boston, and all day teams were busy hauling the material to Brookline.

The entire work of transporting and rebuilding the mansion will occupy two years. As each piece of stone or wood work is taken down it is carefully marked, and upon its arrival at Boston it is placed in a pile where the builders can easily find it when wanted.


