## GOWN GOSSIP.

Large fruit is to be used on the early fall hats not only for informal wear, but for dress occasions.

Black taffeta gowns perforated in an all over design of the English embroidery kind are reported from Paris. They are lined with a contrasting color and are trimmed with jet and fringe.

For wear with linen or other light material jacket gowns are shown collar and front pieces, miscalled gimpes. They come in pink, blue, mauve and yellow, in combination with white, and are very pretty and cool. They are easily made at home and may be varied almost endlessly.—New York Post.

## An Illuminated Monument.

A novel monument by Bartholdi to the aeronauts of the siege of Paris is to be erected in Montmarire or its vicinity. It will stand about sixty feet high and be capped by a balloon of bronze and glass or transparent mica. Its diameter will be about ten feet, and inside will be an electric lamp with a reflector, so that by night the monument will be illuminated. The balloon will be guided by a symbolical figure of the genius of Paris, and under it a mother with her dying children will represent the city of Paris.
