A New Kind of Crookes Tube.

Dr. J. Mount Bleyer of New York writes to the Medical Record to describe a form of Crookes tube with which he is experimenting for therapeutic purposes. He seeks to obtain from this object the violet and ultraviolet radiance ordinarily obtained with a powerful arc light. The outward form of Dr. Bleyer's bulb is the same as that of any other X ray tube, and it may be excited by either a static machine or an induction coil. The only novelties in the construction relate to the degree of vacuum and the placing of the poles or terminals inside. The color of the light given off differs from that of an ordinary Röntgen tube in being dark purple instead of green.


