**Bonus For Telephone Employees.**  
Cleveland, O., July 23.—President Dickson of the Cuyahoga Telephone company of this city, in a circular letter to all employees, announces that, as an experiment, one-fifth of the surplus earnings of the company will be set aside and distributed among its employees in proportion to their salaries dating from July 1. The plan is adopted in the belief that it will result in a more efficient service, greater economy and larger earnings and if successful will be made permanent after a trial of six months. Several hundred employees are affected.

**No Battle in Wyoming.**  
Cheyenne, Wyo., July 23.—Sheriff James Fenton, with his prisoner, Jim McCloud, guarded by a posse of ninety men, has arrived at Basin, the county seat of Big Horn county. The sixty mile ride across a country full of friends of the prisoner was without incident. It is understood that McCloud will be charged with having been implicated in the murder of Sheppman Benjamin Minnick.

**Elks' National Parade.**  
Baltimore, July 23.—The Elks now in national convention marched in a grand parade about 7,000 strong, and this proved to be one of the most attractive features of the annual gathering. It is estimated that 200,000 people witnessed the parade, and the marchers were enthusiastically cheered from the beginning to the end.
