Big Bargain in Grain Elevator. Ogdensburg, N. Y., Aug. 3.—A million bushel grain elevator, with the wharfs and appurtenances, of the Prescott Elevator company at Prescott, Ont., sold at auction by order of the high court of justice, has been secured by the Montreal Transportation company for \$65,000. It cost \$300,000. It will now be used in transshipping grain for export by the St. Lawrence route.
