Trains leave Barre for Burlington, St. Albans, Rouses Point and Ogdensburg at 8:30 a. m. and 3:05, 5:30 and 12:01 a. m. Trains connect at Essex for points on Rutland road and the 5:30 connects with New York train for Montreal and points west. Leaves Barre at 3:05, 5:30 and 12 m.  
For Williamstown leave Barre 1:20 and 4:30 p. m. Leave Williamstown at 7:30 a. m. and 2:30 p. m.


