WOMEN AND THE WAR

What the Russo-Japanese Conflict Means to Them.

STRUGGLING AT MAN'S WORK.

Two Thousand Japanese Women Are Laying the Great Sewer in Tokyo. How Korean Women Are Doing the Work of the Country—Primitive Implements Used.

Two thousand Japanese women laying the great sewer in the streets of Tokyo; a hundred thousand Korean women, mayhap, plowing the fields with rude heavy implements...

The women who are struggling with Tokyo's sewer mains are first and foremost struggling with the problem of something to eat.

Two thousand Japanese coolies who were laying the sewer dropped pick and crowbar to take up rifles and side arms and march away across Korea.

In Korea the women are doing the work of the country. That means that the Korean women are doing the things which must be done to support life and decrease discomforts to the bearable point...

Korean women are tilling the fields and grinding at the primitive mills. To them manual labor may be less hard than to the Japanese women because it is not so new.

The implements and methods of work are most primitive. When soil is to be turned for the planting of millet, ropes are attached to the sides of a large spade and a woman tugs at each rope while a third woman holds the handle and steers the dull blade into the ground.
