**Blue Light to Soothe Pain.**  
A new anesthetic for use in dental surgery has been discovered, a report from Geneva says, by Professor Redard and Professor Emery. Experiments to learn the effects of colored lights upon the nerves revealed that blue light is extraordinarily soothing, says a London dispatch to the New York Journal. A patient was put in a dark room, and his eyes were exposed to a sixteen candle blue light for three minutes. This caused him to lose the sense of pain, and the tooth was then painlessly extracted without the after effects of ether or chloroform.
