ABOUT THE STATE.

Items of Interest Gleaned From Our Exchanges.

The federal grand jury at Rutland Friday reported nine true bills and one not found, and adjourned to November 21.

Mr. and Mrs. James Davis, of North Poultney, will celebrate their 50th wedding anniversary Wednesday evening, October 18.

Another body, that of Mitro Dansik, of West Pawlet, has been recovered from the Vermont State Co.'s quarry at West Pawlet, where a cave-in occurred October 6.

The Rev. I. W. McLaughlin has accepted a call to the pastorate of the Universalist church at Lyndonville, and will begin his duties there the first Sunday in November.

Odillon Luthier, the cigar maker, who left Burlington August 16 and whose departure had been referred to as a mysterious disappearance, is said to be hale and hearty in a lumber camp in upper Canada.

Thomas Morey, has been brought from North Adams, Mass., to Bennington to answer to a charge of larceny from a building in Stamford. It is claimed that he stole a large amount of jewelry. He denies the charge. Morey has a long court record in North Adams.

In municipal court at Bennington Wednesday the hearing in the case of State vs. Truman Kimball, charged with selling cider contrary to law, was adjourned until October 21. Kimball furnished bail for his appearance in court. The charge against Kimball who runs a cider mill in Pownal, is that he furnished cider to two negroes now in jail. Kimball has had more or less trouble with the colored people of Pownal.
