

REMARKABLE INCREASE

Since 1890; Then \$65,037,091,197—Railroads and Equipment Worth \$11,244,752,000—Latest Report Taxable Property \$55,607,719,435.

Washington, Nov. 15.—The United States census bureau has estimated the total wealth of the country in 1904 to be \$106,881,415,009. This shows an increase above the estimates for 1900 of nearly 21 per cent and is 64 per cent above the estimate of 1890, when the total wealth was \$65,037,091,197.

In 1904 the value of real property taxed was \$55,607,719,435; real property not taxed, \$6,669,527,174; live stock, \$4,073,791,736; railroads and their equipment, \$11,244,752,000; materials and products of manufacture, \$7,469,386,000; furniture, carriages, etc., \$3,700,000,000; manufacturing machinery, etc., \$3,297,754,180; gold and silver coin and bullion \$2,002,330,373; clothing \$2,500,000,000.
