

DOG LICENSES.

In accordance with Act 97 of the Laws of 1900 and Chapter 38 of the Ordinances of the City of Barre all owners or keepers of dogs in said city four weeks old and over must cause the same to be registered, numbered, described and licensed for one year from the first day of April 1907. All licenses are payable on or before April 1st.
