WHAT THE WORLD IS DOING AS TOLD IN LATE MAGAZINES. Ellen Terry's Rehearsal. Ellen Terry, the greatest English actress of our day, who has "charmed and captivated millions in her fifty triumphant years of stage life," has written her "Memories" and McClure's Magazine has the good fortune to publish them. The first number, "Memories of My Childhood," appears in the June McClure's and from time to time other delightfully captivating portions of the great Terry's memories will appear in the magazine. Terry's account of her first part as "Mamilius" in the Keans' London production of "A Winter's Tale," is full of fascinating detail. We quote a portion of what she says of her first rehearsal: "The rehearsal for 'A Winter's Tale' was a lesson in fortitude. They taught me once and for all that an actress's life (even when the actress is only eight) is not all fun and glory! I was cast for the part of Mamilius in the way I have described, and my heart swelled with pride when I was told what I had to do. But many weary hours were to pass before the first night. If a company has to rehearse four hours a day now, it is considered a great hardship, and players must lunch and dine like other folk. But this was not Keans' way! Rehearsals lasted all day, Sundays included, and when there was no play running at night, until four or five the next morning! I don't think any actor in those days dreamt of lunch! How my poor little legs used to ache! Sometimes I could hardly keep my eyes open when I was on the stage, and often, when my scene was over, I used to creep into the greenroom and forget my troubles and my art (if you can talk art in connection with a child of eight) in a delicious sleep!

How to Get Pure Milk. A very important article of the month is "Rochester's Pure Milk Campaign," by Samuel Hopkins Adams in the June McClure's, in which Adams describes Rochester's pure milk campaign that began ten years ago and resulted last year with its municipal supply of pure milk in the raising of the lives of one hundred and fifty children under five years of age, at a cost to the city of Rochester of about seven dollars and a half per human life. "It is a cheaper price for that commodity than any economic statistician (since Mamilius) has ventured to set. To preserve life so insignificant an expense is perhaps the most expert, specific achievement of modern American hygiene. In establishing such a standard Rochester has set an example for other communities to ponder, to take pattern by, as in time all our cities must, to improve upon as, happily, some of our cities in the fullness of time may."

SEA BATHING IN CUBA. If You Are Tempted to Try It, Resist the Inclination. If you should chance to visit Cuba, officially or otherwise, and should desire to go in sea bathing, remember the advice of the Englishman—don't. For sea bathing in Cuba, like the ways of the heathen Chinee, is peculiar. The natives probably go through it as a religious penance, as considered in the light of a diversion. It is simply ghastly. Say you reside in Havana, and, attracted by the beautiful tides of the tropic sea, you desire its titillating saline refreshment. You will notice, as you drive along the Malecon, immediately below that fine sea wall some curious masonry construction like the ruins of cells, over which the waves dash and disport themselves. These are, in fact, the remains of former baths that before the Gringo came were used by the natives. You will further notice that there prevail along the Malecon drive odors not at all suggestive of Araby the Blest, and when you find upon closer investigation that the odors are not wholly removed from the fact that all the sewers of the city seem to empty into the sea just below the wall you acknowledge that this fine Malecon promenade has its drawbacks.

The banos, or baths, are out at Vedado, a suburb of Havana, and you are likely to enjoy the drive along by the coast some six miles. The fringes of Havana, as you leave the city proper, are shabby enough, but there's the sea to gladden the eyes, and you anticipate sporting in those bright blue waters with relief.

The first intimation you have of the baths is the apparition of a frame structure that looks like a grand stand. You enter this and purchase your ticket. Then the misery begins. After the usual preliminary process, similar to that prevalent in a watering place in the United States, you go forth, expecting to come upon a sandy beach. Instead, you tread painfully upon sharp rocks, and the sight of the place where you are expected to bathe gives you the horrors. It is a cell cut in the sea, through which the water sprays and regurgitates with the advancing and retreating waves. This cell, if you have nerve enough, you descend into by means of steps, taking care not to slip, for the rocks are like soap suds to the action of the seaweed. The bottom of the cell is formed of the rough rock, while sharp flints are plentifully strewn about. Your feet are soon lacerated and bleeding.

Suddenly you feel something nip your leg like a pair of powerful tweezers. You put your hand to the afflicted part and find that it is a crab that has laid hold of you. You glance about in hopeless desperation and see that other crabs are coming forth, with landable politeness, to welcome you to this aquatic bower of bliss. "What in thunder," you think, "is the idea in walling you up in this fashion? Is it a survival of Spanish cruelty?" Then, as your gaze wanders out to sea, you see a long grayish black body shoot swiftly past. The explanation of the walling in part of the transaction is explained by that long, swiftly moving body, for this coast is infested by man eating sharks, and bathing without the precaution of a wall in front of you, with an opening in it just large enough to fill the cell with water, would be likely to prove more gratifying to some hungry shark than to you.
