ONE KILLED. Gasoline Tank Blows Up on Boston Fishing Boat.

Gloucester, Mass., June 17.—One man is dead, another is dying and nine are painfully burned and injured as the result of the explosion of a gasoline tank aboard the Boston auxiliary fishing schooner Alert, while docked at Cais-John's wharf, yesterday afternoon at 3 o'clock.

The local firemen fought hard to save the craft from destruction, as a fire followed the blowing up of the gasoline tank.

With a mighty roar the entire forward deck of the Alert was blown into the air, while a dozen men were working in her hold packing ice in preparation for a trip for mackerel on the Cape Shore.

A great sheet of flame shot through the hold of the vessel to the place where the crew was working. Not a single man of them escaped being scorched.
