VERMONT'S INSANE. Biennial Report of State Hospital at Waterbury. The tenth biennial report of the trustees of the state hospital for the insane at Waterbury for the term ending June 30, 1908, has just been issued.

Without giving credit for the cash received from private and part pay patients and paid to the state treasurer, the actual cost of patients per week was \$3.62 8-10 each.
