Unequal Battle at Topsfield, Mass., But Former Won

MANY SHOTS WERE FIRED

Rev. A. B. Dunn, Pastor of Congregational Church, Successfully Defended His Home To-day and Was Not Hurt.

Topsfield, Mass., May 1.—Rev. A. B. Dunn, pastor of the Congregational church in this place, proved himself a hero today while at the same time he was defending his home from a party of burglars.

The Rev. Mr. Dunn had previously provided himself against just such a deprecation by securing a revolver. He had this weapon in his hand when he caught the burglars in the act.

The unequal battle ended with the minister in possession of the field of battle and his property intact, while nobody had been injured in the encounter.

NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR WIFE KILLING

In Attempt of the Defense of Chester Jordan to Prove in Court To-day.

The Defense Ends Its Case.

Boston, May 1.—With the answering of a short hypothetical question propounded by Drs. McDonald, Page and Jolly, alienists for Chester Jordan, the defense closed to-day, the doctors declaring that the prisoner was not responsible for killing his wife, Honora Jordan, and dismembering the body.

Dr. George F. Jelly testified that he examined Jordan four times—on April 11 and 13, and twice on April 28.

"As a result of those examinations are you prepared to say that Jordan is suffering from some malady?" "I think so."

"What do you think of his appearance alone?" "I think he has been a sufferer from epilepsy from early life. I think he is an epileptic with organic brain disease. He probably has general paralysis, but I am not prepared to say that positively."

"From all that you know of the case, and of the defendant, do you think that the homicide was committed while Jordan was suffering from a major seizure of epilepsy?" "I think it might."

"And if he was in an epileptic fit at the time he committed the deed, would he be able to distinguish between right and wrong?" "I think not."

BOND PUSHED OVERBOARD.

Hostile Demonstration Against Former Premier of Newfoundland.

St. John's, N. F., May 1.—Sir Robert Bond, the former premier, met with a hostile reception yesterday when he attempted to land from a steamer at western Bay, the centre of the Bay de Verde district, to address a political rally.

Sir Robert is touring the towns and villages along Conception bay in the interest of his party. When he started to go ashore from his steamer he was met by a crowd of voters in sympathy with Sir Edward Morris' party and warned that the electors of Western Bay did not desire to hear him.

FOR PAVING CUTTERS

Concessions Were Made on Both Sides Yesterday but the Cutters Got Practically All They Had Asked For.

Concord, N. H., May 1.—At a conference last night between the committees of the paving cutters' union and the granite manufacturers' association an agreement was reached on the new bill of prices which went into effect today.

Under the old bill the cutters got from \$17 to \$22 per thousand, according to size, and they demanded a raise ranging from \$17.50 to \$23.50.
