GOV. HASKELL HIT IN FEDERAL COURT'S RULING

Demurrers of Defense Overruled in Town Lot Cases Involving Use of Dummies.

Muskogee, Okla., May 10.—Federal Judge Campbell overruled Saturday the demurrers of the defendants in the Mott Creek Indian land suits, civil proceedings brought by the government against Gov. Charles N. Haskell and other prominent Oklahomans.

The decision, involving as it does, the legality of millions of dollars worth of lots, created consternation. Not only are Gov. Haskell and his associates involved in the charge of fraud, but about fifteen hundred subsequent purchasers of lots are vitally interested.

These suits were brought by the government for the Creek Indian Nation to recover for that tribe Muskogee town lots aggregating 3,000 acres, and alleged to have been obtained by Gov. Haskell and the other defendants by the fraudulent scheduling of "dummies."
