UNCOMPLIMENTARY TERM

Hollingsworth, Who Criticized Davis Picture, Laughed At Southern Editorials About Him Put on Record.

Washington, May 18.—"An ass of the first magnitude" "perhaps one of Sherman's bums who robbed defenseless men and women" "contemptible little whelp" "a political nonentity from Ohio" "a pale faced luminary" "a pusillanous pigmy from Ohio."

These were some of the characterizations of Mr. Hollingsworth of Ohio in editorials which he had read in the House of Representatives yesterday as the basis of a question of privilege offered by the speaker.

Finally, Messrs. Bartlett of Georgia and Fitzgerald of New York objected to further "umbering up the record" and demanded that the speaker rule on the question of privilege.

Later, Mr. Hollingsworth sought unanimous consent first to print a speech on the subject, or else to address the House for 30 minutes.

Mr. Harrison of New York objected whereupon Mr. Hollingsworth wanted the speaker to tell why the objection was made.
