

**\$1,000,000 BLAZE  
AT DAYTON, OHIO**

Business Section of the City Was  
Threatened By One of the Worst  
Fires in Its History.

Dayton, Oct. 22.—Property losses aggregating close to \$1,000,000 were sustained and the destruction of the business section of the city threatened by a worst fire in the history of this city which started in the Wolf building at an early hour yesterday morning. Spontaneous combustion in the paint room of the Dayton-Computing Scale company is believed to have been the cause of the fire. The scale company's loss was \$200,000, partly covered by insurance. The fire was not under control until 8 o'clock in the morning and the firemen were compelled to watch a tank containing 3,000 gallons of oil within 50 yards of the fire, which would have threatened the entire section if it had exploded. The site of the Wolf building was the scene of a disastrous fire in 1900.

**IRA A. SHATTUCK DEAD.**


For 12 Years Secretary of 2nd District  
Republican Committee.

Hardwick, Oct. 22.—Ira Anson Shattuck died suddenly at the New England sanatorium in Melrose Wednesday night. Mr. Shattuck has been a victim of Bright's disease for some time and went to Melrose about a month ago for treatment.

Ira Anson Shattuck was born in Wheelock February 21, 1846, son of Anson Shattuck, whose father was one of the first settlers of that town. He obtained his early education at Derby academy and a Boston business college by which institution he was later employed. Returning to Vermont, he became a jeweler and watchmaker which trade he has since pursued, being proprietor of a store in Hardwick at the time of his death.

Mr. Shattuck was postmaster here from 1875 to 1883 and from 1890 to 1891. He had been town clerk and treasurer since 1901. He was for 12 years secretary of the second district Republican committee. He was a member of Otisville Lodge, No. 87, A. F. and A. M. He leaves a wife and two children, Mrs. Williams Fraser and Mrs. Fely Shattuck, both of Hardwick.
