MARRYING IN FRANCE Official Obstacles That Bar the Way to the Ceremony.

THE WORRIES OF A FIANCÉE He Has to Brave the Incidence and the Incapacitation of the Civil Officers in His Efforts to Accomplish the Necessary Preliminary Formalities.

Marrying in France is not an easy matter. On the contrary, the civil officers seem to enjoy ingenuously in putting so many obstacles in the way of those who contemplate matrimony.

Take the case of a French citizen who until recently resided in the Eighth arrondissement of Paris, but who removed to the Ninth and then began to accomplish the formalities necessary for his marriage.

Smiling and happy, as a man about to wed himself, he presented himself at the mairie of the Ninth ward with the following documents, which he had previously obtained at the mairie of the Eighth arrondissement: His birth certificate, his discharge from his army, the death certificate of his parents and the certificate of his first marriage, for he had been married once already.

On a Saturday afternoon at 4 o'clock he called upon the functionary whose business it is to attend to matters affecting the "etat civil." Eying the visitor coldly, the functionary asked: "What do you want?"

"To get married," replied the other, smiling. "It's closed." "Beg pardon?" "I said it was closed for marriages. Come back on Monday or Thursday."

"Why Monday or Thursday instead of Tuesday or Friday? What reason?" "How should I know? And do you think I care? It's like that—that's all I know."

On the Monday the fiance returned. He had recovered his good humor and his smile, and the first document he handed to the employee at the mairie was his birth certificate, which had cost him originally 2 francs.

"What's that?" exclaimed the functionary, with an air of surprise. "It's too old."

"What do you mean—too old?" "I mean, what I say. Your certificate was made out eight years ago, and it has been used already. I don't want that. I must have one that is not older than three months."

ABOUT THE STATE Rev. J. Blanchard 78 years, died December 23 at the home of Rev. W. A. Wilson in Ferrisville. He had been in poor health several weeks.

Samuel Holden, 78, the veteran conductor of the Vermont and Massachusetts and Fitchburg division of the Boston and Maine railroad, died at his home in Cambridge, Mass., last week. He was the oldest conductor in Massachusetts in point of service. He was a native of Orange and a member of the Masonic bodies in that town. He ran his last train in July of last year, being obliged to give up at that time because of declining vitality.

The equipment of the Brattleboro Retreat is to be increased this year by the building of a \$50,000 gymnasium and nurses' dormitory. All of the stone used in the construction, as well as all of the work lumber, will come from the Retreat property, thus saving about \$20,000. Another item that will greatly reduce the amount of cash needed to construct the building is that of labor, which will be largely provided for by the employees of the institution. The building will be 120,000 feet on a ground of two acres and a half in height above the daylight basement. The erection of this new building is made possible by the gift of Mrs. Richard Bradley, whose husband was one of the trustees of the institution from 1875 to 1904. The cost of the building will be considerably in excess of Mrs. Bradley's gift, but the plan is to complete as much of the building as the funds will permit and carry on the work from time to time as money accumulates.

VERMONTERS' NOVEL DINNER. Boston, Jan. 3.—There will be an unusually lively interest in the coming dinner of the Vermont Association of Boston, which is to be served in Mechanics building on Wednesday evening, January 6, for the affair is going to be different from any that the organization has ever had. Heretofore, the members of the association, all of whom are sons of the Green Mountain state who have come to Boston and, won success here, have gone to a hotel for their annual dinner, but this season, owing to the attractiveness of the annual gathering and the harking back in Mechanics building, they have decided to go there for their dinner this winter, and, what is more, to make it something that should catch the Vermont spirit in every respect.

Have the turkeys all come from Vermont, and let the participants in the feast be divided up into little groups so that the occasion might have the appearance of a monster series of family reunions. The idea seemed a happy one, and with that in mind the preparations have been going on under the direction of an efficient committee, which is headed by Isaiah B. Clark and Edmond A. Barnham, president and secretary, respectively, of the association.

The reception will be at 8:30 o'clock, and after greeting the distinguished guests, many of whom will come from Vermont, the party will march to the hall, where all the place will be fitted with small tables, each seating ten, so that families and former fellow townsmen will have chances for jolly reunions.
