

JEFF ANGRY AT CHARGE

Offers His Entire Purse to Charity

IF GILLETTE PROVES IT

Starting from Chicago to Return to California, Gov. Gillette Doesn't Retract Anything from His Previous Statement.

Rowardennet, Cal., June 3.—James J. Corbett, who has been settled as spokesman for Jeff's camp, says that the fight is positively not a frame-up. Jeffries, being mad, says he will give all his money to any charity Governor Gillette names if he can show the fight to be a fake. Corbett said, "My honesty in the ring was never questioned and the same is true of Jeff. There has never been a breath of scandal concerning his career. The man never lived who can say that Jeffries ever entered into a crooked fight. He is going to win on the level."

GOVERNOR CONFIRMS STATEMENT

Disgusted With Whole Thing—Fight Will Be Closely Watched.

Chicago, June 3.—Confirming his statement to the United Press that he believed the Jeffries-Johnson fight would be a fake, Governor Gillette left today for the West on the train to his denunciation of the fight. "I am sick of the whole thing and don't care a continental what anybody thinks of my statement. It was my personal view. I know what I think."

500-ACRE LAKE ENTIRELY DRAINED

Causing Freshet on the Sebasticus River in Maine Yesterday—Flood Caused by Workmen.

Bangor, Me., June 3.—A violent freshet of peculiar origin caused considerable damage yesterday on Sebasticus stream, a tributary of the Piscataquis river. The Northern Manufacturing company of Bangor in order to get at mineral deposits used in the manufacture of paint, sent a crew to drain the water from a lake on the pond farm, so-called, five miles above Howland and close to the Sebasticus stream, into which the lake has an artificial outlet. The men made too large an opening and a washout of the bank for several hundred feet followed, allowing the entire body of water, about 500 acres in area, to rush into the Sebasticus.

The stream was immediately raised 10 to 15 feet, washing out the Whitney hill road for a considerable distance, carrying away an almost new iron highway bridge and threatening the safety of about 12,000,000 feet of logs at Howland.

SUICIDE BY GAS.

Fall River Woman Left Gas Cocks on Stove Open.

Fall River, Mass., June 3.—Mrs. Annie Kavolsky, 25 years of age, residing at 285 Bedford street, ended her life last night by inhaling illuminating gas. Her body was found in the kitchen of her home beside a gas stove. There were seven gas cocks on the stove, all of which were open.

The discovery was made by her husband, who had left her but two hours before. Before inhaling gas Mrs. Kavolsky had put her three-year-old daughter to bed in an adjoining room. The child was unaffected by the fumes.

Medical Examiner Gunning gave a verdict of suicide through gas poisoning. Dependence is believed to have been the cause for the deed.

HELD AT ST. JOHNSBURY

Alleged Thieves Who Broke Into Bath, N. H., Postoffice.

Concord, N. H., June 3.—Postoffice Inspector Will Stone, was notified by telephone yesterday of the apprehension of the thieves who broke into the postoffice at Bath, N. H., on Thursday of last week. The men were caught at St. Johnsbury, Vt., and will be brought into the New Hampshire jurisdiction for trial.

REFUSED TO PAY THE COSTS.

Mrs. George A. Keyser Is Committed to Jail.

Laconia, N. H., June 3.—Mrs. George A. Keyser, a woman 60 years old, was committed to the Belknap county jail yesterday afternoon on a capias execution issued in favor of Mrs. Evelyn Kelso, who was defendant in a suit brought by Mrs. Keyser. The original suit was entered by Mrs. Keyser in the superior court for the March term, 1907, and a jury trial was held May 11, 1909, at which a verdict was rendered for the defendant. A motion for a new trial was granted, and the second trial, March, 1909, resulted in another verdict for the defendant. The matter involved in the suit was a determination of a boundary line between two pieces of wood and timber land owned by the respective parties. In connection with the suit a petition was brought for an injunction, and a temporary injunction was granted, restraining the defendant from cutting wood and timber on the disputed tract.

It is understood that Mrs. Keyser refuses to pay the execution for costs rendered against her, which amount to a sum of over \$90. On being incarcerated the custody stated that the Lord had always taken care of her and she had faith that he would in the present instance. Mrs. Kelso and her attorneys allege that Mrs. Keyser recently encumbered or disposed of her real estate and other property. Under the law, Mrs. Keyser has the right to make application to the justice of the peace to take the poor debtor's oath, and it is thought probable that she will do so, and should a hearing be held upon a petition of that kind, the facts relating to her alleged disposition of property would have to come out.

Mrs. Keyser has a husband and son who are residing at the Mountain View house, on the road between Meredith and Center Harbor.

CHILD KILLED BY TRAIN

And Its Father Tried to Do Harm to the Conductor.

Franklin, N. H., June 3.—Lydia Yared, 3-year-old daughter of Mr. and Mrs. George Yared of 40 Willow street, was struck by a train on the Franklin & Titon branch of the Boston and Maine railroad yesterday afternoon near her home and killed.

The child, with her little brother, Charles, and Jerry, a 2-year-old son of Mr. and Mrs. Frank Yared, was out walking with Miss Marlow, who is employed at Yared's. They were going along a curve beside the track. Engineer A. F. Lake of the south-bound passenger train did not see them in time to stop.

Mrs. Marlow grabbed the Hutton boy and little Charles and threw them to one side, but the engine struck Lydia. She died about an hour after the accident.

Mrs. Thomas C. Beatty, a neighbor, saw the danger, the four were in and cried out to Miss Marlow.

Mr. Yared is an Assinippi chieftain. He and his wife were crazed with grief at the affair and the efforts of City Marshal George A. Hackett, who was in charge of the train. The track runs alongside the street where the accident happened and there is no fence between the rail and the highway.

WAS THROWN FROM HIS HORSE.

August Belmont Nearly Killed While Playing Polo.

New York, June 3.—August Belmont was thrown from his pony yesterday afternoon while playing polo at the Meadowbrook Hunt club on Long Island. For a time there were many rumors that he had been seriously injured but at his house last night it was said he had only been badly shaken up. At the Meadowbrook club it was said that he had a broken wrist.

The pony was in full gallop and its tripping turned a somersault. Fortunately Mr. Belmont was thrown clear. The horse rolled over and over several times but did not strike Mr. Belmont with its feet and did not roll upon him. Mrs. Belmont was immediately notified by telephone and hurried out to the hunt club in an automobile. She brought her husband back with her to their town house, where it was said last night that Mr. Belmont had been able to eat dinner with her.

At Hempstead, Long Island, where Mr. Belmont has his country place, however, the village reports were that Mr. Belmont suffered a broken rib, that his scalp was torn, and that his face was badly bruised and lacerated. Moreover, it was said that the pony fell on him so heavily that he lay breathless on the ground and that it was necessary to resort to artificial respiration to bring him back to consciousness.

MRS. HOWARD PENSIONED.

Widow of General Granted \$100 a Month by Congress.

Washington, D. C., June 3.—The House yesterday passed a bill granting a pension of \$100 a month to Mrs. O. O. Howard, widow of Maj. Gen. O. O. Howard. As originally passed by the House, the bill provided a pension of \$30 a month, which the Senate increased to \$100. There was considerable opposition, there being a fixed rule of the House limiting the pensions of widows of general officers to \$30 a month.

The fight for the increase was led by Representative Foster of Vermont. Mrs. Howard has long been a resident of Foster's home city, Burlington. Senator Frye was very active in obtaining the pension. He was a personal friend of Gen. Howard.

EUGENE SPAULDING BURIED.

Odd Fellows Take Part in Last Rites at Franklin, N. H.

Franklin, N. H., June 3.—The funeral of Eugene Spaulding, who died in Everts, Vt., was held there and the body was brought here yesterday afternoon for interment in the family lot in the Franklin cemetery. Mrs. Spaulding, 28, is the widow of Eugene, who was a post office grand, conducted services at the grave. Mr. Spaulding was formerly a boss spinner in a local hosiery mill. He was about 60 years old. He leaves a wife at the family home in Bethel, Vt., a son, Scott Spaulding of Boston, and a daughter, Mrs. Leon A. Hackett of this city.

TAFT FAMILY TO ARRIVE JUNE 23

At Their Summer Home in Beverly, Mass., and Arrangements Are Being Made There.

Beverly, Mass., June 3.—It became known last evening that Mrs. William H. Taft, with Helen, Charles and Robert Taft, will arrive at the summer White House at Beverly, Mass., on June 23, for the remainder of the summer season.

It is expected that President Taft will make a flying trip to Beverly with his family, in order to see that they arrive safely, after which he will return to Washington.

Mrs. Louis T. More, sister of Mrs. Taft, who spent the summer here last year, will be in the party, and she will stay here until the arrival of the president, about July 5, for his long vacation.

Mrs. R. D. Evans, who is President Taft's landlady, arrived yesterday at her summer home at Burgess point, which is a short distance from the summer White House. She will spend the season here.

Opposite the Taft residence has been placed a handsome fountain, purchased by the late Robert A. Evans, when he was in Italy, at a cost of several thousand dollars.

The avenue leading to Burgess point have been put in the condition, as well as the grounds about the house, and everything will be in readiness on the arrival of the family.

The board of trade held its last meeting of the season yesterday and will turn its quarters over to the president for his office quarters. These quarters were used last year by the executive department.

THREE ALOFT AT ONCE.

Spectators at Hempstead Heath Witness Novel Sight.

New York, June 3.—Spectators of the aeroplane flight over Hempstead Heath on Long Island yesterday saw three aeroplanes aloft at once, circling, passing and re-passing each other at various altitudes. Charles H. Hamilton went up 1000 feet in a Curtiss biplane and remained aloft for half an hour.

The veteran Captain Baldwin, made a cautious trial in a machine of his own invention.

Clifford B. Harmon, made a trial of 12 miles in a Farman biplane at a height of 200 feet and came to grief in landing. He smashed his propeller, and snapped several stays, but escaped personal injury.

Jointly With Lord Cromer, British Agent in Egypt.

London, June 3.—Theodore Roosevelt and Lord Cromer, British agent and consul-general in Egypt from 1893 to 1907, were guests at a dinner given last night by John St. Lee Strachey, proprietor of the Spectator, in honor of Mr. Roosevelt. They sat on either hand of the host. Colonel Roosevelt and Lord Cromer are believed to be perfectly agreed on Egyptian policies and that the complaints of sentimental Londoners, which the former president voiced at the Guildhall had all arisen after Lord Cromer's administration.

London, June 3.—Theodore Roosevelt, called on Joseph Chamberlain today and spent an hour with the veteran statesman. William McMillan of the Justice Africa ranch, invited Roosevelt, after which Roosevelt paid a visit to the country home of Arthur Lee.
