





**NERVES NEED SCOTT'S EMULSION**

Frederick G. Bundy of St. Johnsbury, whose skull was severely injured not long ago by a fall from a train, is making a satisfactory recovery after an operation whereby a graft of silver of considerable size was grafted into the bony covering of the brain.

Christopher Niles, the police officer who severely burned one hand in a vain attempt to rescue Miss Vena Pine of Burlington from burning to death, finds that the tendons were destroyed and that the hand will always be more or less crippled.

Jack Mann was quite badly injured while lumbering in the woods in Concord last week. He had fastened the chain to a log and given the signal to another man to start, unaware that the end of the chain struck in the snow was around his ankle. He was thrown on his back on the log, and his leg drawn between a stump and log. It is thought a bone or two were broken, the limb is badly bruised and it will be some time before he is able to work again.

H. A. Blake of Sutton has a record probably unsurpassed by anyone in New England, having been correspondent for the same paper for 42 years, the publication being the St. Johnsbury Caledonian. In that time he has been in a position to note the changes of time and the times themselves if there is not a man in town who was living there 40 years ago and but two women, Mrs. O. E. ### FIRE AT WOODSTOCK.

Dear Sir: I telegraphed you this morning as follows: "St. Johnsbury Commercial club request your support Canadian reciprocity bill. Kill pension bill." Our organization has taken considerable interest in the Canadian reciprocity measure now before Congress. We are disappointed that our representatives voted against this bill, and we hope and trust that you may see your way clear to support it. It seems to us that the ultimate results of this measure will be all for the good, and we earnestly request your support. We also feel very strongly against the pension bill as it passes the House of Representatives. It seems to us a wicked waste of the country's money. It is probably a fact that a few deserving veterans might be benefited by this bill, but the vast majority who will benefit by it are not entitled to anything from the government. It is regarded by our people generally as a bid for patronage. We hope you will vote against it.

### THE RUTLAND AS A LEMON.

A Railroad Kicked About from Pillar to Post—An Old Freight Man's View.

"Say," began the traveling freight man from the middle West road, "I'll bet the New York Central bunch were mighty glad to stick half of the Rutland land off on Mellen. It was their lemon."

"Of course they didn't want to let go either, because it would allow Mr. Mellen to bring Montreal business down the valley from Bellows Falls to New Haven and then into New York."

"Vanderbilt said he'd be—but you can't print the word he used; anyway, he said he'd be so if he ever took the Rutland off 'the Doctor's' hands. And the Doctor was his brother-in-law, too. Vanderbilt had already taken that Rutland off the Doctor's hands, and he and his brother-in-law, Gardner & Legare, Groton, Vt. J. A. Dodge, Waita River, Vt. L. P. Hight, West Topsham, Vt. R. E. Beard, Orange, Vt.

"So the Doctor continued to run the Rutland after paying a fancy price for his partner's, Percival W. Clement, stock which Clement had bought cheap and was unloading on the Doctor at fancy prices. In the end, however, Vanderbilt got concerned where sister's money was going to and one day read the riot act to the Doctor when he was over in Paris, so Webb turned the road over to the New York Central."

"The Rutland's' career has been well termed 'checked.' It was independent, then it was leased to the Central Vermont, next independent again, then a part of the New York Central lines, and now it has been neutralized under the joint partnership plan."

"While it was leased to the Central Vermont, the Delaware & Hudson company held a large part of the stock. It sold out to the Clement and Webb party. When the Central Vermont went into receivership and the new management of the Grand Trunk took the Central Vermont for debts owed, the Grand Trunk did not want the Rutland or the Ogdensburg and Lake Champlain and both went to being their own road. Mr. Clement at the head of the Rutland and Charles Parsons reorganizing the Ogdensburg road."

"Parsons sold his end, 118 miles, to the Rutland in about 1900. The Rutland ended at Burlington and the Ogdensburg road at Rutland Point, and over forty miles intervened—forty miles of hostile track, controlled by the Grand Trunk. The Rutland built a rock caseway
