SMALLPOX VS. CHICKENPOX. Differences Between Diseases Considered By Vermont Board of Health. The June bulletin issued by the Vermont board of health gives the following comparison of smallpox and chickenpox: "The diagnosis between smallpox and chickenpox is frequently difficult, owing to the extreme mildness of the smallpox cases. The early symptoms may be so slight that only a temporary indisposition is noticed, and by the time the patient feels entirely well, there are some points which aid in the differentiation; and these may be summarized as follows: In chickenpox, the trunk of the body, that is, the part covered by clothing, presents the most lesions, and the face, hands and extremities are comparatively free; whereas, in smallpox, the hands, face and extremities are most markedly involved.
