

KING GEORGE HURT

Official Report Says That the British Monarch Was Thrown from His Horse While He Was Reviewing His Troops on Thursday, but Other Details Are Withheld

HORSE FRIGHTENED BY CHEERS OF MEN

The Animal Reared and Felt, Carrying the King Down—A Later Bulletin Says King George Passed Fair Night—Went to France Early in the Week

London, Oct. 29.—King George was thrown from his horse yesterday and severely bruised. The official announcement said: "While the king this morning (Thursday) was inspecting his army in the field his horse, excited by the cheers of the troops, reared up and fell. The king was bruised severely and will be confined to his bed for the present.

A later bulletin said the king had a fair night.

It is understood that the accident was not serious, although no details have been made public beyond those disclosed in the official announcement.
